

LR Things Guard for Litter-Robot 4 Installation Instructions

Included Parts: 1x Sticker 2x Alcohol Wipes

Step 1: Wash your fence with soap and water and let dry completely.

Step 2: Practice by taking the brown/white sticker and place it on the fence so you can get the positioning of how you'll attach it in Step 5.

Step 3: Take one of the alcohol wipes out and wipe the area on the fence where the sticker will go. Let dry.

Step 4: Take your Guard and remove one side of the paper or plastic protective covering. Use the second wipe to clean the lower part of the Guard where it will meet the sticker. Let dry.

NOTE: For Glossy/Matte colors, you will need to decide which side you want shown BEFORE you remove any of the protective covering. To see which side is which I suggest you pull back one of the top corners to expose the finish on each side to make your decision. Then remove the opposite side's protective covering, leaving the side you want facing out covered (you do this so you won't harm the finish during Step 10).

Step 5: Carefully take only the white backing off the sticker and hold by the edges, the adhesive is very thin and sticky so take care not to get it stuck to your fingers. Then apply it to the fence taking care to not get any air bubbles between the sticker and the fence.

Step 6: Use your fingers to make firm strokes over the brown part of the sticker. Then take something like a AA battery to rub over the brown part of the sticker with firm pressure all over. We want to make sure the adhesive on the sticker is firmly attached everywhere to the fence. Go over the whole sticker several times. Let it sit for several minutes before continuing.

Step 7: Starting at one of the top corners slowly and carefully pull back the brown side of the sticker at a 45 degree angle. If the adhesive is pulling up with the brown paper, lay the paper back down and really rub that area again. The adhesive on the sticker is very thin so take care not to rip it while removing the brown paper covering.

Step 8: Once the brown covering is removed take the acrylic Guard and position it over the sticker, taking care to properly align it with fence, then slowly lower it down and firmly press the Guard onto the sticker.

Step 9: Use your fingers to make firm strokes over the Guard, really pressing down to make sure the Guard adheres to the sticker. Using the AA battery again in firm strokes all over.

Step 10: Let the Guard sit while the adhesive sets up for 5-10 minutes. Then you can remove the plastic or paper covering and install the Guard on your Litter-Robot 4!
